General Scholarship Information**

- Bishop State Community College offers a variety of scholarships. Selection of scholarship recipients is highly competitive. Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee a scholarship.
- High School Institutional Scholarships cover the cost of in-state tuition and fees for two years, provided the student maintains a 3.0 GPA.
- Students must be U.S. citizens or resident aliens.
- It is highly recommended that the student apply for FAFSA ([www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov)) by March 1.
- Only students who are awarded scholarships will be notified by mail.

**Scholarship Opportunities**

<i>Institutional Scholarships</i>	<i>Requirements</i>
Presidential Scholarships	Minimum ACT composite score of 24 and grade point average of 3.5. Pays \$10,000 (\$5,000 a year for 2 years).
Academic Excellence Scholarships	Must have taken the ACT and grade point average of 3.25. Pays \$8,000 (\$4,000 a year for 2 years).
Career Technical Scholarships	Technical Scholarship – Minimum grade point average of 2.5. Pays \$8,000. (\$4,000 a year for 2 years). Certificates (\$4,000 only for 1-year certificate programs).
