Food and Housing:

All students have estimated Housing allowance of \$10,600. Amount estimated as follows: The cost of a two-bedroom apartment is estimated at 2000 + 500 for utilities. The student is expected to share the apartment with a roommate. Therefore, 2500/2 = 1250 per month. At 31 days in a month and a student attending class 5 days in a week: 1250/31 = 40 per day. 40×5 days x 30 weeks = 6000. Food of 4600 is estimated at 31.75/300 x 5 days x 30 weeks.

Books and Supplies:

Expenses for taking 15 credits per semester estimated at \$1000 x 2 semesters = \$2000

Miscellaneous Personal Expenses:

Allowance estimated at $8/day \times 5 days \times 15$ weeks $\times 2$ semesters = 1200 for students living with parents.

\$10/day x 5 days x 15 weeks x 2 semesters = \$1500 for all other students, including out of state.

Transportation:

Allowance estimated at $10/day \times 5 days \times 15$ weeks $\times 2$ semesters = 1500 for all in-state An additional 500 is added to the allowance for out-of-state students due to the additional expenses incurred for travel to their home states.
