Thank you for your interest in Bishop State Community College. The Office of International Students is here to help you with your F-1 VISA paperwork and serve as a resource for International Students. Listed below is information that needs to be completed before you are admitted to Bishop State.

First Year Students (Students in Home Country)

- Admissions Application
- Official High School Transcript - **(Must show graduation date, school seal, and translated in English)**
- Test Scores: TOEFL (61) **or** IELTS (6) **or** ACT Scores **or** SAT Scores
- Affidavit of Financial Support **or** Bank Letterhead Stationery **or** Bank Statement (showing balance of minimum \$15,000.00 USD) **or** Financial Guarantee/Scholarship (Documentation should be dated within 6 months of Admission date)
- Current copy of F-1 VISA, Passport, and I-94

Transfer Students (Students transferring from College/University within the United States)

- Admissions Application and SEVIS Information Checklist
- Official High School Transcript - **(Must show graduation date, school seal, and translated in English)**
- Official College Transcript from each college attended – **(Must be official and translated in English)**
- Current copy of Form I-20
- Affidavit of Financial Support **or** Bank Letterhead Stationery **or** Bank Statement (showing balance of minimum \$15,000.00 USD) **or** Financial Guarantee/Scholarship (Documentation should be dated within 6 months of Admission date)
- Current copy of F-1 VISA, Passport, and I-94
