

Pell Policy for the summer crossover 2010

Bishop State Community College will determine assignment on a case-by-case basis: students assigned to 2009-2010 are treated under the old rules (no comparison to determine the higher payment, and the College will use its own interpretation of acceleration), and the students assigned to 2010-2011 are treated under the new rules (payment is based on the comparison of which award year yields the higher payment, and the new regulatory determination of acceleration applies) – in other words, the College assigned summer 2010 to the 2009-2010 award year but on a case-by-case basis will assign students who will receive a higher payment out of the 2010-2011 award year to the 2010-2011 year. Acceleration is not required to get a payment for the summer 2010 out of the upcoming (2010-11) award year since, as the first term to that award year; it is paid from the first scheduled award for that year.
