

Who is Required to Take ORI101 in the Academic Year 2015-2016?

Beginning in the Fall of 2015, ORI101 will be offered on the Main Campus ONLY and will become a part of the General Education Curriculum (AS and AA degree plans) and ASL. Students with a General Education Degree Plan may enroll in ORI101 with financial aid paying for the course and students are strongly encouraged to do so. [All other students may register but must self-pay.] Beginning in Fall 2016 all First-Time Students (FTS) will be required to enroll and successfully complete ORI101.

For Fall 2015 the following students are **REQUIRED** to enroll and successfully complete ORI101:

- Entering FTS at Bishop State, (students with less than 30 credit hours of course work); and
- All FTS placed in two or more of the following developmental courses (COMPASS PLACEMENT) as defined by Alabama State Board of Education Policy 802.01: ENG092, ENG093, RDG083, RDG084, MTH090, MTH098, and MTH100.

Note: Students not required to enroll in ORI101 are transient students and high school students enrolled in dual enrollment courses.

Additionally, all FTS on Institutional Scholarships (athletic, band, choir, cheerleading, academic-college bowl, creative writing, drama, elementary school tutoring, and presidential - leadership) are **REQUIRED** to take ORI101 and successfully complete this course in their first semester.
